
I have been thinking over the situation involving Brooklyn Core, New York Core and Bronx Core. I have the following suggestions to make which require immediate action.

- a. Charges should be prepared against all three groups and if they take part in the demonstration "Stall In", these charges should be served immediately.
- b. Copies of the specific charges should be sent to all NAC members.
- c. In addition to the groups involved action should also be taken against specific individuals, probably the officers of the groups. Charges should be filed against them.
- d. Action should be taken to take over the bank accounts, treasury, and other assets of the organization. By this I mean that we should know where the money is and if the NAC takes action to disaffiliate them, then the NAC should also take over all property belonging to CORE.

By the time you get this letter I am sure that most of the action will be over and it will be just a question of waiting for the NAC meeting. It would probably be best if the charges were filed by McKissick as National Chairman. He should be the focal point of the political fighting not yourself.
